## Terms and Conditions

- 1 This year we are having two categories: 1. Work based on the theme (Metamorphosis) 2. Work based on any theme you wish.

The definition of Metamorphosis from various dictionaries is

- \* A complete change of physical form or substance
  - \* A complete change of character, appearance, etc
  - \* A person or thing that has undergone metamorphosis
  - \* Zoology: the rapid transformation of a larva into an adult that occurs in certain animals, for example the stage between tadpole and frog or between chrysalis and butterfly
  - \* A complete change of form, structure, or substance, as transformation by magic or witchcraft
  - \* Any complete change in appearance, character, circumstances, etc.
- 2 If you choose to enter the themed category, you can take the theme in any direction you wish.
- 3 £5 entrance fee is payable for each piece of work submitted and must be included with your application form by Sunday 4th March 2018. Work must be at Craft Arena by 4pm on Saturday 31st March 2018.
- 4 Work must not have been displayed or exhibited before.
- 5 There is no size limitation. If however your piece is large, you will have to supply your own display (for example a quilt stand if you submit a quilt).
- 6 Please indicate in the box provided on the front page if you will be supplying staging. Your work will be refused entry if Craft Arena feels any staging supplied by you does not meet Health and Safety requirements with no refund of your entrance fee.
- 7 You may use any technique from mixed media, embroidery, cross stitch, through to lace making, silk painting and fabric collage etc., although the work should contain some form of textile, i.e. fabric, thread etc
- 8 All work must be ready to hang with eyelets and hanging wire. If attachments for hanging need to be added by Craft Arena, a £5 charge per item will be made, payable before the work is hung.
- 9 No responsibility will be taken for damage to exhibits if hanging attachments need to be added or if hanging attachments provided by you fail.
- 10 Monies raised by the entrance fee will be divided between the prizes for the entrants, customers who vote in the competition and a donation to St. Luke's Hospice.
- 11 Work must be collected by 4pm on Sunday 29th April 2018. Any work not collected by this time (apart from prior arrangement) will be disposed of.
- 12 If you wish to sell your work, 30% commission will be taken from all items sold therefore the selling price of your work should be calculated to include this.
- 13 Craft Arena reserves the right to increase the asking price of work without consultation if it is felt the work has been undervalued. No reduction in valuation will be made without consultation with the artist.
- 14 Whilst every care will be taken with the exhibits while they are in the possession of Craft Arena, items are not insured and remain the responsibility of the exhibitor.
