You will have a choice of poppy or seagull papers to work with, plus lots of tags, pockets and embellishments to add to make this concertina journal your own. In the morning we will be painting, cutting and sticking, and in the afternoon putting the pages together with straight and zigzag stitching using your sewing machine and a little hand stitching should you want to. You can bring your own machine, or use one of ours. A requirements list is available on our website where you can also book your place.

Requirements List

You will need:

- Red, light green, dark green, mauve, black colouring pencils.
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Fine line pigment marker
- Paper scissors
- Glue Stick
- Narrow double sided sticky tape
- Apron and gloves (we have disposable ones if you need them)
- Sewing machine set up for straight stitching - capable of zigzag stitch and one or two decorative stitches. Free machining is not necessary for this workshop.
- Red, green and blue threads
- Basic sewing kit

This workshop is for anyone who likes to play around with paper and stitch or those who would like to try it for the first time.

If there is any equipment you do not have, please let us know and we may be able to lend it to you. Phone us on 01268 523780 if you have any queries.

You can bring your own lunch to eat in the studio or outside if the weather is fine, or visit the Tiptree Tea rooms to purchase food.

The studio is a slight walk away from the car park, so you may prefer to bring your sewing machine on a trolley. There is a lift to the first floor. If you need any help please ask.
