Zentangle Classes

Zentangle is an easy-to-learn, relaxing, and fun way to create beautiful images by drawing structured patterns, consisting of a combinations of dots, lines and simple curves. These patterns are drawn on small pieces of paper called "tiles", so called because you can assemble them into mosaics. Zentangle is non-representational so you can focus on each stroke and not



worry about the result; the result is a delightful surprise. As you use the Zentangle Method to create beautiful images, you can enjoy increased focus, creativity, self-confidence and an increased sense well-being.
